## **MOST Expands Reduced Admission for All New York State EBT Cardholders**

The Milton J. Rubenstein Museum of Science & Technology (MOST) is expanding its Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) Cardholder Program to include all New York State EBT cardholders.

Effective immediately, the MOST is offering a discounted admission rate for all New York State residents holding EBT cards. Cardholders will pay just \$2 per adult and \$1 per child ages 2 to 11 for admission to MOST exhibits. Other attractions within the Museum are available at regular fees.

"It's our privilege to be able to expand this successful program to all New York State residents," said Lauren Kochian, MOST Interim President. "Our MOST core values include a commitment to STEM education, accessibility and inclusion. This program touches on all three."

EBT cardholders will be asked to show their EBT card and a photo ID to qualify for the reduced rate.

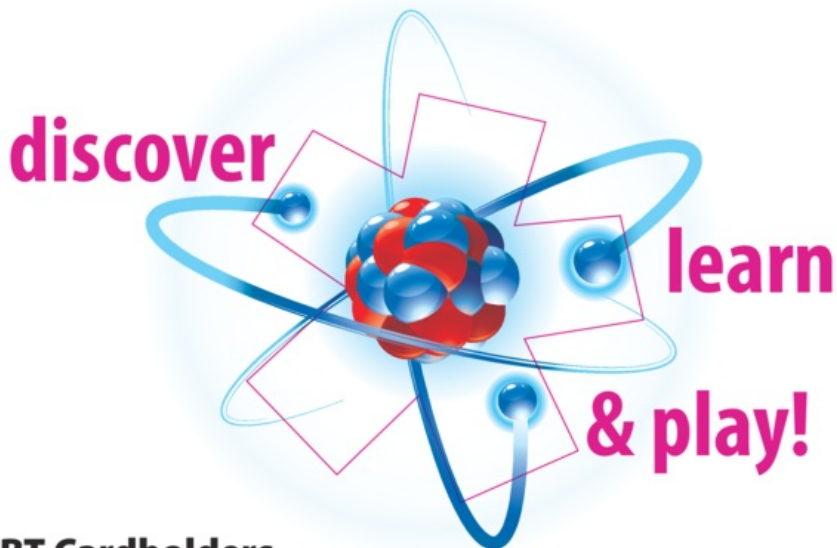
